REPEAL OF BYLAW #06 – TOWN SEAL AND CREST BYLAW**

AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act (MGA), Section 13(1) Perpetual succession and seal - A municipality has perpetual succession and shall have a common seal.

Local government bylaws may only be amended or repealed by by-law. Amendment and repeal by-laws are subject to the same requirements as the legislative authority to establish a new one. The adoption procedures outlined in Part VII, By-Laws, Sections 168 and 169 apply to all by-laws including a repeal by-law.

TITLE - This By-law is entitled the “Repeal of Bylaw #06 – Town Seal and Crest Bylaw.”

PURPOSE - Bylaw #53 hereby repeals Bylaw #06 – Town Seal and Crest Bylaw.

EFFECTIVE DATE - This bylaw is effective March 31, 2020.
