

## TOWN OF WINDSOR 2019/20 GRANTS

At Windsor Council's March 26, 2019 Council meeting, the following Grants to Non-Profit Organizations were approved and letters/grants will be issued late June/early July:

- Mermaid Theatre of NS \$1,000 & continued partial tax exemption
- Hants Co. Christmas Angels Continued use of Community Centre for event
- WH Ground Search & Rescue \$600
- Hants Co. Senior Games Committee \$600
- Windsor People First \$250 & continued use of present office space
- Windsor Senior Citizen Bus Society \$1,900
- Windsor Hockey Heritage Society \$1,900 & continue with in-kind snow removal and continued support with the annual Long Pond Heritage Classic
